Modern Slavery Statement

Connect 2 Cleanrooms is publishing this statement in line with the requirements of Section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 ("the Act"). Although the company size excludes us from falling within the scope of the Act, we strongly believe in the principles and actions it seeks to embed.

The Company provides trusted solutions and proven expertise, taking the complexity out of cleanroom ownership. We acknowledge the responsibility placed upon companies by the Act and seek to ensure transparency across the organisation and with the suppliers of goods and services to the Company.

The Company recognises that slavery and human trafficking is an evil that inhabits our global society and our aim is play our part in its eradication through alerting and developing our team to recognise the risks within our own business and those within our wider supply chain.

The Company has a strong procurement strategy and vetting process in place to ensure suppliers comply with the Act.

The workforce is employed by the Company directly and due diligence is performed on any new employee joining Connect 2 Cleanrooms Limited, irrespective of whether they are a UK or foreign national.

The Company aims to identify and mitigate risk by taking the following steps:

- Regularly vetting our supply chain and ensuring all new suppliers are fully checked and onboarded
- Continually auditing and reviewing HR best practice by checking all employees have the right to work in the UK and our salary structure exceeds the legal minimum wage
- Encouraging all employees to voice any concerns and report them to the senior management team


